ADM is committed to sustainable, responsible practices, and throughout 2020 we continue working to uphold our sustainability values in the Cerrado.

Our [Doing it Right Program](#), an environmental and labor compliance assessment program for our direct suppliers that incentivizes best management practices at the farm level, expanded to include more growers, adding 50.000 more hectares to the amount of properties participating in the program.

As a member of the Soft Commodities Forum (SCF), we are on track to deliver our commitment to traceability to farm by the end of 2020, and we strive to continue making collective sector progress on best practices to map and report traceability to origin in the soy supply chain. In Brazil, we are continuing to fulfill our commitment to

the Cerrado Working Group (GTC), focusing on developing pragmatic and collaborative solutions that address local sustainability issues.

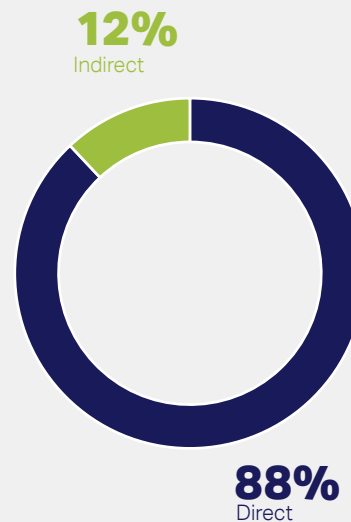
Soy volume sourced in Brazil (data from 2019)
